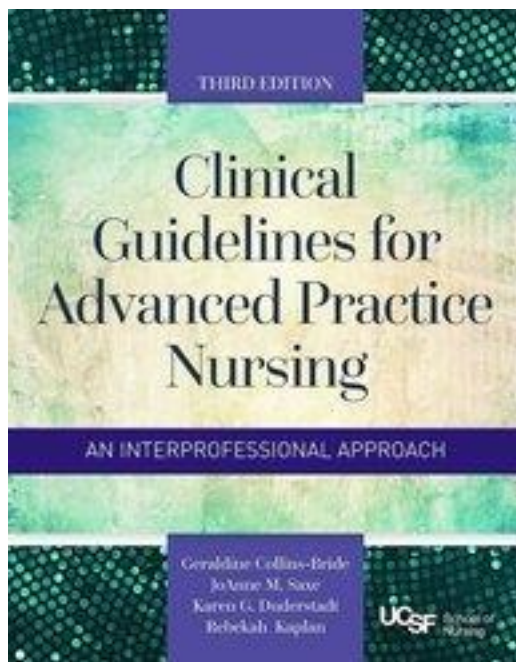

The authors highlight disease and procedure-specific guidelines to assist the clinician in rendering sound clinical decisions to implement accurate treatment plans.

The ***Third Edition*** is written in the S-O-A-P (Subjective-Objective-Assessment-Plan) format to underscore the process of clinical decision making. For ease of reference it is divided into the following ambulatory care specialty areas: Pediatrics, Gynecology, Obstetrics, and, Adult General Medicine. The text focuses on the continuity of care through its coverage of the health care conditions and procedures commonly seen and done in ambulatory or primary care settings.
