

### **Summary**

Clinical Guidelines for Advanced Practice Nursing: An Interprofessional Approach, Third Edition is an evidenced-based and practical resource for advanced practice nurses at any level of expertise. The Third Edition has been significantly updated and highlights the complex health care conditions that advanced practice nurses often encounter in ambulatory care settings. The authors highlight disease and procedure-specific guidelines to assist the clinician in rendering sound clinical decisions to implement accurate treatment plans.

The *Third Edition* is written in the S-O-A-P (Subjective-Objective-Assessment-Plan) format to underscore the process of clinical decision making.
