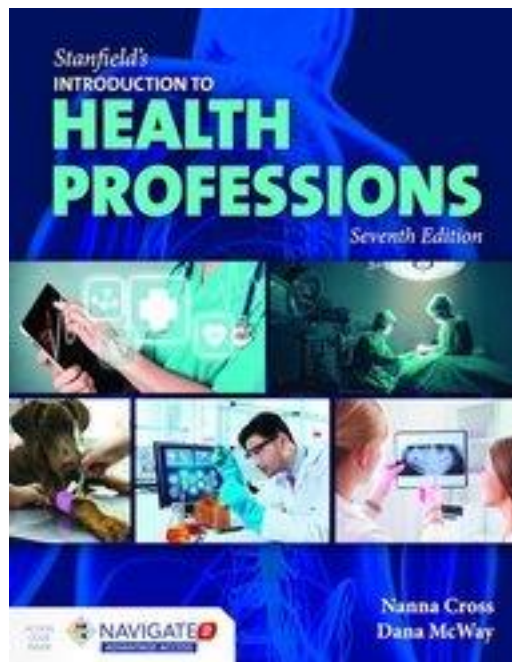

HOW IS THIS BOOK ORGANIZED?

The new Seventh Edition of this text has been reorganized into five sections:

- **Part 1 – The Health Care System in the United States:** This section provides an overview of the health care system in the United States with separate chapters on categories of health services, financing health care, the impact of aging on demands for health care providers, healthcare reform and medical and information technology.
 - Thoroughly updated to reflect changes to the healthcare system since the publication of the previous edition, including the Affordable Care Act
 - Includes a new chapter on Health Information Technology
- **NEW! Part 2—Jobs & Careers:** This new section focuses on Job Preparation and Fulfillment as well as Career Development
 - Previous Part II: Health Professions Involving Patient Care is now broken down into 2 new sections: Part III: “Healthcare Practitioners and Technicians” and Part IV: “Healthcare Support Personnel”
- **NEW! Parts 3-5:** Contains chapters on individual careers. Each chapter follows the same format with a description of the professional and typical work setting; educational, licensure and certification requirements; salary and growth projections; and internet resources on educational programs and requirements for licensure and/or certification.  - **Part 3—Health Care Practitioners and Technicians:** This section contains over 20 chapters covering health careers that involve direct patient contact and care, ranging from diagnosis to treatment to education and counseling and medical or surgical interventions.

- **Part 4—Healthcare Support Personnel:** This section contains four chapters covering health careers that support or supplement other health professionals in providing ongoing care for patients—medical and nursing assistants, personal, home and psychiatric aides; medical information technology; and massage and recreation therapy.
- **Part 5—Health Related Professions:** This section focuses on health related professionals that usually do not have direct contact with human patients but often have an impact on human health—veterinary medicine and occupational health and environmental sciences.
