How to Use This Text to Pass the TCRN Certification Examination

If you have downloaded the TCRN Content Outline, you will notice it is divided into major sections. The book is formatted in much the same way, except the content in each section varies somewhat. In addition, the headings differ in places.

This author created a new section titled, "Special Populations I" to include Pediatric, Geriatric, and Bariatric content. Rather than adding Obstetrical to this mix, there is a section titled "Special Populations II," with Obstetric and Neonatal content to facilitate study.

Questions are written in the same style that appears on the exam. Not all questions involve complicated scenarios or explanations. There are very straightforward questions that involve recall, but also critical thinking. Rationales may also be simple or complex. A question may be written in different ways and appear in multiple sections. A variety of presentations allow the reader to stay engaged.

There is a computer code provided with the book. The code will allow access to the same questions as found in the written text. You can review the material on a variety of devices. In addition, you can mix and match questions to customize a practice exam. Keep reviewing the questions until you can confidently answer 80% correctly.

Remember, you can pass the TCRN exam. Take your time, be confident!
