So instead, I provided the link to the page on FileMaker Inc.'s website where they are updated more frequently than I would be able to on my own site.

Third-party developers created most or all of the plug-ins on this site. FileMaker, Inc. only offers information about them as an aid to users, but does not vouch for the plug-ins themselves or their makers.

I myself had recommended a plug-in to one of my clients. Once it was installed and we had a problem, the developer seemed to disappear from the face of the earth.
